

Hotels in San Diego

Due to the large geographic area of San Diego County and City, there is no simple guide to appropriate lodging. San Diego is made of many small communities, beach towns and incorporated cities. I-5, I-805, and I-15 are the three major north-south corridors which are bisected by our east-west freeways, I-8, and SR 52, 54, 56 and 78. Many national hotels, in all price ranges are situated along all of these major highways.

For proximity to all weekend events, the hotels in the areas of Mission Bay, Old Town, San Diego Bay, Hillcrest, Fashion Valley or Hotel Circle would be the most convenient locations. In addition to major hotel/motel chain links, be sure to look at the multiple Bed and Breakfast facilities. The prices are competitive with the large hotels, and offer a romantic, historic and delightful change of pace. The B&B's are located in the suggested areas, and do not involve the 'big city issues' of inexpensive motels.
